We are very pleased to be able to inform you that the Corfe Mullen Youth Trust runs a Community Youth Club in the Community Hub. This is based in the old Youth Club building which is now managed by Lockyer's School and used as a music classroom during the day. This has been done with great support from the Trustees and Corfe Mullen Town Council.

Along with this letter is a new membership form which for safeguarding reasons must be completed and signed prior to or on your child's first visit to the club, It is a requirement of membership.

If you would like to meet the staff and find out more about what will be happening when the club opens please drop in and see us on our first week commencing 14th Sept and we will be pleased to answer any questions you may have. All sessions are staffed by fully qualified youth workers and volunteers, all of whom have been DBS checked.

Club nights are as below. Your child may have another activity already on their club night this doesn't mean they cannot be members or can't join in on the activities when they are available. You will still be included in emails unless you opt out by letting me know.

Our club nights for members are:-
Tuesday for Year 9 and above
Thursday for Year 7's
Friday for Year 8's,

Sessions are between 7.00 pm and 9.00 pm and cost £2.

As well as club nights we also run a free drop in session for all members on Tuesday and Friday afternoons after school 3.30 – 5.30pm at the Village Hall by the Council offices. Please note: Youth Workers are not responsible for the children during these sessions as children are free to come and go, however, they will be available to offer advice and support. A drink and snack are provided.
