



CORFE MULLEN YOUTH TRUST MEMBERS CONTRACT

I understand the club's expectations of me and what the consequences will be if I choose not to behave within the boundaries set by this agreement.

SMOKING

Smoking is strictly prohibited both inside the building and on the whole site.

CLUB BOUNDARIES

It is expected that members stay in the building we are no longer allowed to use the car park for games. If weather and staff permit they can use the field. Any member found in any other area may find themselves excluded for a period of time and their parents informed. Parental permission must be sought by a member of staff prior to members leaving the site.

ILLEGAL SUBSTANCES

Illegal substances are not allowed on the school or club site. We may need to follow up by advising Police and/or Parents. A meeting will be held with the Youth Worker, Parents and the young person to discuss the best way forward.

BEHAVIOUR

Members are expected to have respect both for each other and the Staff and the Centre. Failure from the member to abide by the agreement will mean suspension from the club.

EQUIPMENT

Mistreatment of equipment will result in less equipment for members to use, and a bill for the damaged equipment may be sent to the members home. Accidents can happen and if genuine, the above rule will be relaxed.

PHONES

Year 7's must hand in phones at registration and they will be kept secure until the end of the session.

SUBSCRIPTIONS

No subs, no entry. There are strictly no IOU's. Subs are our main source of income. Without these the programme would be restricted.

VALUABLES

There is no safe place for valuables so beware. The staff may look after valuables but they cannot guarantee their safe keeping.

CAR PARK

Members are not allowed to use the car park for any activities in the evening including before and after a club session.

Chewing Gum

It is a building rule that chewing gum is not allowed

By becoming a member of the club and completing the registration form, I understand I must abide by the above rules. Should I choose to challenge one of the rules the procedure is that the Youth Worker will contact my parents and will ask for me to be collected. I will only be allowed back in once a joint meeting with myself my parents and the Youth Worker have met and discussed my actions and a way forward.
