ITEM 4 Retrospective actions

Re-opening

That the earliest the Hall will open is Monday 7th September. Full refunds to be given to those with bookings in July and August (cancellations had already taken place up to June 30th).

Staff have been furloughed to 30 June and a decision is required as to how to proceed with staff arrangements beyond 30 June. The government has stated from 1 July, employers can bring furloughed employees back to work for any amount of time and any work pattern, while still being able to claim the grant for the hours not worked. From 1 August 2020, employers will be asked to contribute towards the cost of furloughed employees' wages.

The Council should consider the staffing requirements, if any, for July and August in preparation for re-opening in September. If staff are to continue to be furloughed beyond 1 August 2020, what contribution, if any, will be made to furloughed staff salaries.

ITEM 5 Covid-Safety

The Council set up a working party to undertake the necessary actions to ensure that the Council's workplace, employees and public areas are safe as the lockdown restrictions ease.

Risk assessments are being carried out and controls which need to be put in place have been identified. Further advice will be sought from Ellis Whittam and amendments made as the government advice is issued and updated.

Bookings will be considered in light of any current guidance and hirers will be expected to provide their own risk assessments in addition to being issued with the risk assessment for the Village Hall to ensure that all possible precautions and measures are taken to protect staff, hirers and the public.
