Cross straight over on to Roman Road and walk its length, some gravel then tarmac, up to junction with Highfield and Lancaster. Cross straight over overgrown half left towards Beacon Road. Exit on to Beacon Road and walk its length down to Roman Road.

Turn left and walk up tarmac Roman Road until you come to a bridleway straight ahead which takes you up to Springdale Road.



Cross straight over on to Roman Road and walk its length, some gravel then tarmac and pick up Roman Road (as a footpath) behind the bus shelter. Information Board about the road at the start.

Walk along the footpath, pass 1st turning left, until the path becomes gravel and descends downhill.

Look for 2nd turning left which becomes a tarmac path, by gas installation box, down to Phillips Road.

Cross road and turn left and then right into library

gardens and car park.



- ▶ Walk length of lane until you reach Old Wareham Road. Holme Bush Inn is on your right.
- ▶ Turn left, cross road and walk up to "T" junction at Naked Cross.
- ▶ On the right look for bridleway at the side of the landfill site, which takes you up to the Upton Heath. Take main path across the heath do not turn off right around the landfill site.
- ▶ Head half left towards Beacon Road. Exit on to Beacon Road and walk its length down to Roman Road.
- ▶ Turn left and walk up tarmac Roman Road until you come to a bridleway straight ahead which takes you up to Springdale Road.
- ▶ Cross straight over on to Roman Road and walk its length, some gravel then tarmac, up to junction with Highfield and Lancaster. Cross straight over overgrown half left towards Beacon Road. Exit on to Beacon Road and walk its length down to Roman Road.
- ▶ Turn left and walk up tarmac Roman Road until you come to a bridleway straight ahead which takes you up to Springdale Road.
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- ▶ Cross road and turn left and then right into library
- ▶ Turn right and walk up to the Wareham Road.
- ▶ Walk along the footpath, pass 1st turning left, until the path becomes gravel and descends downhill.

- ▶ Walk through Knoll farmyard and pick up grassy footpath half left across gravel and between two white buildings: this will take you down to Knoll Lane.




Corfe Mullen Diamond Jubilee Walks

- ▶ Proceed along lane to Candys Farm. On the right before the farm there is evidence of Roman engineering, possibly a Roman signal station.
- ▶ On the bend opposite the farmyard take left hand footpath up a slope, over disused railway bridge, gently rising up to the recreation ground.
- ▶ Turn right along the footpath and walk along the perimeter fence. Enjoy the view over the Stour Valley.
- ▶ Stay in line with the fence when it becomes a hedge, till the corner of the playing field.
- ▶ Take the footpath down to Rectory Avenue.
- ▶ Turn right. Stay on right side around the bend and look for white bungalow no. 19.
- ▶ Follow path between beech hedge and white bungalow down to Brog Street.
- ▶ Turn left and cross Blandford Road into Sleigh Lane.
- ▶ Walk down to end of lane.
- ▶ Turn right along Broadmoor Road (pavement on opposite side safer).
- ▶ At the bend turn right on to bridleway to Knoll Farm Christian Mission Church.
- ▶ Walk through Knoll farmyard and pick up grassy footpath half left across gravel and between two white buildings: this will take you down to Knoll Lane.
